fter spending his life working with the numerous, awkward scrolls or trying to leaf through volume after volume of codex manuscripts, the scribe of old could never have imagined what you and I take for granted. The Bible I use is a little ultra thin reference edition New International Version. It measures 5 3/4 inches by 8 3/4 inches, is less than one inch thick, and weighs under a pound. Yet it contains the Word of God, Scripture, the most powerful writing known to man.

- Penetrates the heart of the reader (Hebrews 4:12)
- Gives insight and understanding (Psalm 119:99-100)
- Builds us up (Acts 20:32)
- Provides light for the pathway of life (Psalm 119:105)

- Gives direction for our steps (Psalm 119:133)
- Makes us wise (2 Timothy 3:15)
- Helps us keep our way pure (Psalm 119:9)
- Judges our thoughts and intentions (Hebrews 4:12)
- Keeps us from sin (Psalm 119:10)
- Gives joy (Psalm 119:111)
- Causes us to overflow with praise (Psalm 119:171)
- Gives us great peace (Psalm 119:165)
- Assures us of an inheritance (Acts 20:32)

You know what thrills me? My little "ultra thin" is just as powerful as all the scrolls and all the codex manuscripts with which the scribes had to wrestle. And I can take it with me ANYWHERE....in my hand and in my heart!
