Based on our perception of how respect, trust and love developed between and among the people of the ESG during a year of meetings, we recommend the following proposal to the congregation as a next step in our efforts toward maturing our Christian life individually, as a church, and for the natural development and revelation of leaders.

GROWTH GROUPS

Purpose:

As individuals and as a church, our purpose is to glorify God by making disciples. God uses relational discipleship to equip His people for His Kingdom work, all for the glory of His name. To God's glory, we get the privilege of participating in His plan of redemption.

A "growth group" is an important way that God shapes our church into worshipping, serving, and faithful disciples. The aim of a growth group is to equip <u>all</u> kinds of people with foundational truths and skills that will help them to worship God more and more fully with minds, hearts, and lives devoted to His service.

There are two principle parts to such groups:

The **first** is the curriculum. The first Christians "devoted themselves to the apostle's teaching." We must know important things about God and ourselves in order to follow him.

The **second** part that God uses to equip people is community. In the same way that the first Christians devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, so they devoted themselves to "fellowship" (Act 2:42). By discussing and even practicing the truths of the Gospel in community we find that God uses other people to shape and enlarge our individual faith.

Being a faithful participant in a growth group is not easy. Though we intend to recognize and honor God's distribution of various talents among us, our goal is to equip each participant for God's Kingdom purposes. Participants will be asked to commit wholly to the task of developing community while prayerfully and thoughtfully interacting with the curriculum.

You will gain from the experience to the same degree that you give to it. God is pleased to grow His people to love and know him more deeply.

The commitment:

In a Christian culture that seems powerfully consumer oriented, it is often easy for people to see themselves as the receivers of the church's ministries. However, God's model is quite different. He sees all Christians in the vital role of ministers — ministers who not only reach out to a dying world, but who also minister within the walls of the church in order to build each other up.
