

Why does our Congregation not yet have Elders?: The Elder Study Group

Why do we exist as Christians, as a church? We exist as Christians and as a church to glorify God. We glorify God by faithfully accepting the price for doing his will. We believe that God uses relational discipleship to equip His people for the work of His kingdom, all for the glory of His name.

It is God who shapes our church into worshipping, serving and becoming faithful disciples. People are equipped to do God's work with foundational truths and interpersonal skills that will help us to worship God more fully with minds, hearts and lives devoted to His service.

Our recent church conflicts are evidence that we are in need of recognizing and embracing the importance that God places on the quality of our interpersonal relationships. We need to peer into the mirror of God's word to see more clearly what God expects (and we are obliged to practice) in our habits of dealing with each other and what our expectations of elders are.

Why have we not yet selected elders? In the opinion of the ESG (elder study group) it is because it would be premature to form our leadership before our church further submits to the:

Discipline of foundational truths (the first Christians "devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching").

Discipline of ministry skills that will help us worship God more fully, with minds, hearts and lives devoted to His service.

Too often in churches the accepted/expected norm is that elders do the administrative work of the church. We may want them to "take care of things" and "solve the problems of the church," and not make too many demands on our time, money and schedules. If the operative faith in our congregation has this point of view, then elders will, with awareness or not, conform to this role of "eldering."

But this situation eventually stunts our growth as disciples of Jesus. We do not yet have elders because we want to make the effort to be better informed by God's will. To that end we propose a period of training and discipline in foundational truths and interpersonal skills in order that we might better obey God in the wholeness of Christ-like lives.
