

Mvurwi, Zimbabwe, Africa

In the early 1990s my mother, Edith Bennett, began to send monthly support to a young preacher in Zimbabwe. She learned of Doubt Chitsiga from a dear friend who was teaching at the School of Preaching in Mutare, Zimbabwe. Doubt had just finished his course of study there and was in need of assistance to begin his ministry. Mother supported him until her death in 2008. James and I have continued to help him since then.

Doubt now has two teenage sons, Comfort and Weldon (named after my father), and his wife Jeukai is in poor health. Life in Zimbabwe is hard, due in large part to a corrupt government and hyperinflation, and the Chitsigas are poor. They survive mostly on the small amount of support provided plus what they can grow for food.

Through the years Doubt has ministered to small bodies of believers in several towns. He often works

with other preachers in outreach programs and continues to participate in refresher courses at the School of preaching. Although his ministry has not resulted in large numerical growth, which sometimes discourages him, he has continued to faithfully care for the flock and his family. We love them and are privileged to have developed a long-distance relationship through the years--brothers and sisters because we have the same loving and gracious Father.
