What would our Sunday feel like after a worship service where the Holy Spirit shook us to our core? What would we tell others about our congregation and our Sunday worship to God if we experienced Him moving us, holding us, comforting us? What would change and what would stay the same?

Look, I know it's hard in the morning to muster up the energy, the passion, the drive, the focus, and the patience with the many things that happen during our Sunday corporal uplifting of our Lord. I get exhausted some weeks and come to church on empty, still called to pour out, but also to be poured into. It's so easy to just come and go saying, "It's just church."

Don't come to church this week thinking of it as another habitual part of your week. Consider this time, this gathering as more significant than others. Consider this time a time to experience the Holy Spirit. Consider this time to be vulnerable to it, be responsive to it and be renewed by it.
