

Happy are they who know that discipleship simply means the life which springs from grace, and that grace simply means discipleship.

Grace matters. But the grace that matters is not cheap, easy grace that dismisses sin and permits the guilty to continue their self-chosen way. Grace that matters costs a person everything...yes, everything!
