This week let us pray for those who are less fortunate, for those who need to know a father's love, THE Father's love. Let us ask God to use each of us to point to Him so that we can be a people who are both loved and loving; consistent.

May God make it so. May we see and feel with His eyes and heart. May God bless each of you as you seek to bless His children.
