There are many more. Watch almost any two year old and you'll see dozens... the pouty face, stomping feet, crossed arms, crying, throwing ones selves on the floor (which seems to hurt a lot less when you're little), rearing backward and stiffening the body. We have lots of ways of letting people know we are just not very happy with them.

What if God used our techniques to let us know when He is not happy with us? He could stomp the floor of heaven and rattle the earth. He could jerk his body around causing all kinds of atmospheric disturbances. He could split the heavens with his cry, sending out flashes of lightening, peals of thunder, sheets of rain and layers of hail. Oh, but wait a minute! Could this mean that what we are seeing today means...?

On the other hand, if God were displeased with us, I mean really displeased, He may very well just keep on loving us, being patient with us, protecting us, keeping us, showing us his way and his glory, drawing us nearer, holding us closer, whispering his love, gently singing over us, "How I love you, child I love you. How I love you child I love you. How I love you!"

Ooh, hearing that, how much more I want to please him...to make him happy, to hear him sing, "How I love you, child..."
