A prostitute and men on a secret mission, a slave and Egypt, a slave and a Babylonian king, a Jewess and a Persian king, a prophet of God and his prostitute wife, a teenage virgin and the Holy Spirit, Jesus and a Samaritan woman, an apostle and a Roman Centurion, Jews and Gentiles in the Kingdom of God. God doesn't hesitate to put together what man thinks are odd couples in order to accomplish his purpose. They work and, unlike man's motives, they are not for profit, wellness, or entertainment but for His will and the love of His creation.

In our American governing system is there a constitutional prohibition for engagement between His Church and the State? The phrase separation of Church and State is not in the Constitution. It does say, "Congress shall make no law

respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof." The government is not to establish a religion and the government is not to interfere with religion. Do you notice that both restrictions in this constitutional statement are imposed on the government and there are none imposed on religion? Does that sound a little new covenant/new testament to you?

Our faith in God and the sacrifice of Jesus saves us, not works. Yet James says, "What good is it, my brothers, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can that faith save him? If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food, and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that? So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. But someone will say, "You have faith and I have works." Show me your faith apart from your works, and I will show you my faith by my works."

And what if we pair that with 2 Thes 1:11-12 "With this in mind, we constantly pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of His calling, and that by His power He may bring to fruition your every desire for goodness and your

every deed prompted by faith. We pray this so that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ."

What does God want of us? Some things are pretty clear. He wants us to be in relationship with Him through the saving grace of Jesus Christ, through prayer, Bible reading, and meditation; to love our neighbors as ourselves; to visit orphans and widows, and to remember those in prison and the mistreated. I think most of us at some time have wished the Bible had more specific answers. Is she the one I should marry, should I take this job, should I buy this house, should we get involved in this? But that's not our God. He provides

us with the basics and plenty of deep stuff to think about and says, "Go out and live your lives always remembering Me. Tell people about Me. Look for Me and you will find Me. Go where I send you. Speak the words I give you. Help those in need."

Is it weird or unfamiliar? Is it totally unlike you? Does it smell bad or is it sick or is it despised by the world? Remember, "My thoughts are not your thoughts," He says. "Don't be afraid, I am with you." He says, "Step into the water. Don't be fooled by the world's standards of success but judge by Mine: the measure of your faith and your obedience to my Holy Spirit. I will do what I will with or without you and I follow no rules of man. I am God Almighty; Creator of all that is Seen and Unseen; the First and the Last; there is none like Me, look only onto Me."

The Tiny Village is in God's hands. We are in God's hands. The tiny village team will continue to pray and work as hard as we can though we don't know the outcome or what God has planned. We will measure our success by our reliance on God, our measure of faith, and our obedience to the Holy Spirit, village or not.
