

Where are the Nine?

As Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem, traveling along the border between Samaria and Galilee, he was met by ten men who had leprosy. They stood at a distance, as was appropriate for those so afflicted, and called out, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!"

Leprosy was incurable and those who had it were isolated, banned from association with non-lepers, social outcasts. Their cry for pity was a cry for *pity*... for Jesus to do something, anything to restore them to life, to relationships, to interaction with the human race.

"When he saw them, he said, 'Go show yourselves to the priests.' And as they went, they were cleaned."

"One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. He threw himself as Jesus' feet and thanked him and he was a Samaritan."

"Jesus asked, 'Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine?"'- Luke 17:11-19

Two thoughts... First, thanksgiving is closely related to praising Go. You noticed that in the story above didn't you?

Then, Jesus appreciates thanks givers. He Wonders why others, also richly blessed, do not also stop to give thanks to God.
