

# Listening to God

It is easy to neglect personal daily Bible reading. And soon, unbelievably soon, it becomes easy to excuse ourselves and justify our failure to be in the Bible. We are just so busy and so stressed by all the demands being made upon our life and time. How can we add the additional stress and guilt that builds when we begin to confront our own failure to make sure we are growing in the Word and that our children are being taught the Scripture. Oh, how harsh the demands! How burdensome the guilt! But the fact remains many of us are not in the Bible very much. Nothing like every day. Many of our children are not being read to from the Bible. And many are not being engaged in the activities of the church developed and designed especially for their very age groups.

Now listen to me. I don't mean to be negative or discouraging. I'm not trying to send anyone a guilt trip. I do however, with deep love, compassion and understanding, feel that I need to gently remind some of us that it is time to get back to Bible reading, *daily* Bible reading. It is time to get back to *family* Bible reading, time to get back to reading the Bible to *our* children, time to get back to telling Bible stories to our children.

And it is time to get back to involving and engaging our children in good godly activities planned and designed for the spiritual good of little children, adolescent children and teens. Lately we have been emphasizing the words of Jesus, "My house will be called a house of prayer." (Matthew 21:13) And we have started doing the things by which we can legitimately make that claim.

But now, let us consider adding a new claim and commitment. That God is to be heard above every noise, above every sound and above every voice. So, we can say, "The Bible will be in our hands, in our heads, and in our hearts."

Every day we pick it up (in our hands), we use our minds to read the words of Scripture (in our heads), and we meditate on what we read (in our hearts).

Today I just want to make this point, Prayer and Daily Bible Reading are essentials to the spiritual health of each one of us and our children. That's it! Thanks for reading this.
