

The Practice of Thankfulness (by Tiffany Rousseau)

This month, I have assigned the kids to do some homework. Other than memory verses, I don't usually give them, "homework" in Sunday School, but this month, I decided to do something different. I printed off "Thanksgiving Lists" for each kid and asked them to write one thing each day that they were thankful for. There are at least enough lines for one thing per day and I told them not to write more than one every day, but to spend some time thinking about that one thing they are thankful for.

Sometimes, we feel super thankful. We can list off all the good things in our lives and say, "Gee, God is so good. Look at all these awesome things in my life I have! Golly, I'm thankful!" Then there are times when we don't feel thankful for anything. You know those days, the wind is howling, the rain is pounding on the leaky rooftop, the kids are whining, there's not enough money, not enough food, and not enough energy to get through the day.

We tend to swing from one end of the thankfulness spectrum to the other.

What would it look like if instead of good days and bad days, the majority of our days were more steady and light-hearted? I believe this can begin with a simple attitude adjustment, one that is gradual and concentrated.

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." (Phil. 4:6-7)

Paul issues us a challenge, so I forward this challenge onto you, fellow Christians. Exchange the time you spend worrying about things for thankfulness this month. Focus on one thing per day, write it on your phone's wallpaper or a whiteboard at home or on your car dashboard or on a sticky note at work where you'll see it all day, and let your heart be changed by the transformative power of Jesus Christ.
