

I Thessalonians I-2:8 (ESV)

Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace.

We give thanks to God always for all of you, constantly mentioning you in our prayers, remembering before our God and Father your work of faith and labor of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ. For we know, brothers loved by God, that he has chosen you, because our gospel came to you not only in word, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction. You know what kind of men we proved to be among you for your sake. And you became imitators of us and of the Lord, for you received the word in much affliction, with the joy of the Holy Spirit, so that you became an example to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia. For not only has the word of the Lord sounded forth from you in Macedonia and Achaia, but your faith in God has gone forth everywhere, so that we need not say anything. For they themselves report concerning us the kind of reception we had among you, and how you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God, and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he

raised from the dead, Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come.

For you yourselves know, brothers, that our coming to you was not in vain. But though we had already suffered and been shamefully treated at Philippi, as you know, we had boldness in our God to declare to you the gospel of God in the midst of much conflict. For our appeal does not spring from error or impurity or any attempt to deceive, but just as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, so we speak, not to please man, but to please God who tests our hearts. For we never came with words of flattery, as you know, nor with a pretext for greed--God is witness. Nor did we seek glory from people, whether from you or from others, though we could have made demands as apostles of Christ. But we were gentle among you, like a nursing mother taking care of her own children. So, being affectionately desirous of you, we were ready to share with you not only the gospel of God but also our own selves, because you had become very dear to us.

Women's Roles

As you are aware, a continuing conversation of women's roles in the church was held during our monthly congregational meeting on Sunday, February 17th. As a result of the conversation, it was decided that we would revisit the topic again after the potluck on March 10th around 1:30pm and it is anticipated that those in attendance will have studied and will be prepared to continue the conversation on the following points:

Can Women:

- Lead Scripture reading during the worship service?
- Lead prayer during the worship service?
- Lead communion?
- Serve communion?
- Preach during the worship service?
- Be a song leader or praise team leader during worship?

During the course of the conversation, the question was raised regarding the issuing of a survey in which individuals may give their preferences about each of these points: yes, no, not sure/no opinion. This survey may be considered after the March 10th meeting.

In the meantime, it was decided that a video the deacons have viewed regarding this topic also be viewed by the members of the congregation as a starting point. The video was prepared by a Churches of Christ minister and details the Scriptural reasoning for the Churches of Christ stand on the role of women in the Church. Members are free to view any information they would like and use that during our conversation on March 10th.
