

Growing Together for the Glory of God: The Elder Study Group

Based on our perception of how respect, trust and love developed between and among the people of the ESG during a year of meetings we recommend to the congregation growth groups as a next step in our efforts toward maturing our Christian life individually, as a church, and for the natural development and revelation of leaders.

The growth groups, consisting of approximately fifteen people each, will follow the same 22 week curriculum.

Each group will meet weekly to share and discuss the previous week's assignment (various schedules and start dates for these groups will depend on the number of participants). We believe by having an intentional and relational process we will grow in our love and knowledge of Jesus and one another.

There are audio tapes available of the sermon presented by Ken Reinke, A Talented Church, and the Elder Study Report presented immediately following worship on January 31, 2016 – thanks to Dale Sanders.

Brief informational statements based on the questions asked are as follows:

- -The members of the ESG will be participants in growth groups.
- -Expectations for participants during the six month study are to complete the weekly assignment,

memorize the weekly memory verse and attend Sunday worship. Childcare will be paid for by the church.

- -The weekly Sunday sermon will not intentionally parallel this program.
- -Various schedules and start dates for these groups will depend on the number of participants.
- -We do not know how often or for how long we will do this we need to see how things go.
- -We do wish for 100% of the church to participate.
- -Once we see how many sign-up we will be able to organize the number of growth groups along with leaders and hosts.
- -Spending more time together by participating in these groups, will develop us into the royal priesthood that
