OUR GREAT BLESSING!

There are many great hymns familiar to us. They are great because of the great message contained within the words. The focuses are greatly uplifting because they are based on great truths drawn from the Scriptures. Because of this, these hymns easy get stuck in our minds and touch our hearts in great ways.

As I tried to sleep this past Sunday evening, I kept waking with a particular stanza of a great hymn running through my mind. This even continued into the wee hours of the morning. I even caught myself beginning to say the words out loud, but stopped so as to not awaken my wife who has gotten used to my mind not shutting down very easily Sunday evenings. The hymn was not one we had sung during services that Sunday, but nonetheless came to mind and greatly encouraged my soul because of the great truth acknowledged.

The words of the hymn were written by Haratio G. Spafford in 1873 in the wake of personal tragedy and loss. [If you are not familiar with the story I urge you to look it up.] The lines running again and again through my mind were, "My sin -- not in part but the whole, Is nailed to the cross and I bear it no more, Praise the Lord, praise the Lord, O my soul!"

Among the places where the writer of Hebrews noted the adequacy of Jesus' offering on the cross for our sins we read...

¹²But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God, ¹³waiting from that time until his enemies should be made a footstool for his feet. ¹⁴For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified." (Hebrews 10:12-14 ESV)

What our Lord accomplished on our behalf was not partial, but complete. His blood has the power to "cleanse us from all sin." (1 John 1:7 ESV) By that "single sacrifice for sins" He has adequately provided "for all time"!

Yes, "My sin -- not in part, but the whole"! That is how blessed I am in Christ. That is your blessing in Christ. And the offer remains for all who would be united with Christ in accordance with His Will. Just as with Haratio G. Spafford, regardless of other circumstances in this life, this great truth can bring us great peace; even in the waking hours of the night. "Praise the Lord, O my soul!"

Speaker – Bob McDaniel

Bob came up with 5 categories of feedback from the congregation to the Spiritual Leadership Team, from the lesser to the most talked about.

#5. A mission-based church: Matthew 7:7 & 8. It's who we are and who we need to be.

#4. Involvement: Luke 10:25-37. Being involved in the community and in each others lives – that is Jesus work.

#3 Love of Family: Romans 12 9-13. If we focus on becoming love – the outreach will come. Die to self in order to serve others.
