As a congregation of followers of Jesus Christ here in Port Orchard, we too must come face to face with the results of racial hatred. We **must** advocate for fair and equitable treatment.

The following letter from a fellowship of believers written and signed by many throughout our nation, was brought to our attention and we feel the need to share it with all of you.

Note: Some of the information in this letter may have changed since it was written.

Spiritual Leadership Team

To Whom It May Concern: We, the undersigned ministers and leaders of local congregations of churches of Christ across our nation, are deeply disturbed by multiple reported acts of violence that have been perpetrated recently against unarmed African American men and women. These incidents have forced us to come face-to-face with the ever-increasing numbers and the results of racial hatred.

The undersigned are specifically calling for justice in the deaths of Ahmaud Arbery, Dreasjon (Sean) Reed, Breonna Taylor, and George Floyd.

Ahmaud Arbery, a young man shot dead by two men while jogging through a neighborhood just outside Brunswick, Georgia. While we acknowledge the arrests of the men implicated in this case, we are deeply concerned that it took two months coupled with a public outcry for the wheels of justice to slowly begin turning.

Dreasjon Reed, 21, was shot and killed by Indianapolis police who fired 13 bullets; most after he fell to the ground. This incident was streamed on Facebook, where one of the detectives can be heard taunting the dying Reed, saying, "Think it's going to be a closed casket, homie."

Breonna Taylor, a young lady who was asleep in her bed was shot 8 times and killed by law enforcement officers, who mistakenly entered into her home in search of a suspect who had already been brought into custody earlier that day. Breonna Taylor was a black EMT who had been working as an essential worker during the Coronavirus pandemic.

Most recently, George Floyd was falsely accused of resisting arrest before being handcuffed and pinned to the ground by an officer's knee. After multiple pleas for help and saying, "I can't breathe", the 46-year-old unarmed man died. Although the four officers have been fired, no formal charges have been filed. It has been reported by news outlets that one of the officers has been the subject of a dozen conduct complaints that resulted in no disciplinary action.

Police violence and selective enforcement are not so much flaws in American criminal justice as they are integral features of it. Our coalition is calling for all accounts of blatant racism, racial profiling, and police brutality to be addressed and for police officers to be properly regulated and, if necessary, prosecuted to regain the public's trust.

Rest assured, we will remain vigilant in addressing these issues and calling out these situations when they occur and will follow these cases, and others like them, to ensure that justice prevails. We join with the families in mourning the loss of these men and women's lives and surround them with prayers for comfort as we work diligently for a world free of racism.

We demand that the officer responsible for the death of George Floyd be arrested and charged with murder, and the officers who watched the murder of Mr. Floyd be charged with manslaughter because they neglected to render aid as a first responder. Likewise, in regard to the officers involved in Breonna Taylors death, they should be arrested and charged for her murder, and any remaining charges to her boyfriend immediately dropped.

In regard to Ahmaud Arbery, we require a transparent legal process that serves as a contrast to the beginning stages of the investigation. We also acknowledge and agree with the assignment of an independent prosecutor, who has garnered our full support to bring this to a just conclusion. We also request a change of venue to ensure a fair and just trial.

Our concerns are not localized only to the tragedies mentioned above. Collectively, we call for every American of every ethnicity, to use their voice to decry the systemic racism that hunts down black and brown men and women. We agree, that no longer will we accept the hollow words of our caucasian counterparts without the investment of their actions concerning our fracturing. We expect for every believer and American, regardless of race, to recognize the value of black lives, and advocate for our fair and equitable treatment.
