1. Is the sermon in Luke the same as the sermon in Matthew 5-7? Why or why not?

2. Is the sermon livable? Can you live up to ideals stated in it?

3. How can we consider it joy to be persecuted for Jesus?

4. Does this sermon speak the problems of life?

5. What are ways you can live out the sermon?

The latter half of chapter 6 is the sermon on the plain. Matthew records this same teaching in the sermon on the mount - Chapters 5-7. In this section of teaching, Jesus gives us the beatitudes and many teachings that were contrary to the teachings of His day. It gives us a look at how we who are His should act in this world; how we should conduct ourselves.

Some commentators have said that these are too lofty for mere man to achieve. What do you think? Can we live up to the teaching that Jesus gives us? We will be discussing this and many other things this Sunday night at 6pm. I hope that you will be able to join us as explore the sermon on the plain.
