
Serious Joy!

C. S. Lewis noted, "Joy is the serious business of Heaven." [from "Letters to Malcom: Chiefly on Prayer"] This reminds me of Jesus' teaching of the lost sheep and the lost coin in Luke 15.

In each of these respectively we read. . . "Just so, I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance." (Luke 15:7 ESV)

And... "Just so, I tell you, there is joy before the angels of God over one sinner who repents." (Luke 15:10 ESV)



Just as sin and departure from God's Will is serious, so is the rejoicing in Heaven over each individual soul turning back to Him! The latter of these two references seems to be an indication of the angels witnessing the rejoicing of God Himself! Tithes and Offerings


Since we are once again meeting inside the building, there is a collection box at the entrance to the auditorium. However, the other options are still available:
