

- 5. Why was Herod interested in seeing Jesus?
- 6. When Jesus fed the crowd, was there a reason?
- 7. What can we draw from the feeding of the 5,000?
- 8. Why did Jesus tell His disciples not to say who He was?
- 9. Explain what it means to take up your cross daily?
- 10. What was the Kingdom that Jesus was speaking of in vs 27.
- 11. What was wrong with Peter's response to seeing Moses and Elijah?
- 12. Who was Jesus rebuking in vs 41?
- 13. Luke records Jesus giving examples of disciples that give excuses why they cannot follow Jesus, what are some that we give?

Jesus is continuing His ministry, crisscrossing the lake, healing and casting out demons. These are windows into the lives of the disciples and the people that Jesus helps. In chapter nine Jesus starts to turn toward Jerusalem and the cross. He knows His time coming, and He needs His disciples to be ready for the challenges that will come their way.
