As her condition improved, they set up Zoom meetings even when we could hardly understand her because of the oxygen mask, what a comfort for her and for all of us. Prayers are working for her and comfort is there because of all of you and our Lord. As her oxygen improves, they hope to be able to allow her to eat. Angela was born with Cerebral Palsy; in most recent years she's had her choking issues and now in the hospital she can't pass the swallow test to allow her to have food. They're considering an NG tube. they had to change up the type of oxygen they were giving her so perhaps she can have the feeding tube. Our thanks to all of you for your prayers and your care for this precious child of God. Our deepest thanks!

Since I was near her but not within the 6 ft range for very long no more than a couple minutes at a time, Darrell and I are going to stay away from folks for at least 5 days. We feel confident that we were not infected but feel it wise to be cautious for a few days to make sure there are no symptoms. * Update: Before this was sent out the doctor called with an update on Angela. We are so thankful for all of you that prayed for Angela. The doctor shared that yesterday they were very worried for Angela and had her evaluated by the ICU doctors because they weren't sure she could tolerate the mask and they were considering intubation. She is a long way from coming home but is improving, they will try to wean her off of the machine and back to the high concentrate O2 through the nose.
- Sneads: Please pray for the Snead family, their daughter Kirschon, husband Gus and daughter Aubri have all tested positive for Covid. May God protect them all and bring them back to full health.
- Debbie: Tanya Howard's dear friend Debbie is suffering greatly with pain and it appears there are multiple areas of cancer. Today she was admitted to the hospital. Debbie needs our strong prayers to comfort her and her family and to be with all the doctors that attend her.
