### The MIGHTY HAND!

Writing to Christians going through severe trials, Peter urged and encouraged... *“Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.”* (1 Peter 5:6-7 ESV)

Two actions are urged here.

First is that of humbling self. The Greek translated “humble” is in the imperative; it is a command. God is to be acknowledged as the One on the throne!

The second action is the casting. Peter urged his readers to cast all of their anxieties on God. As God is duly acknowledged as the Sovereign on the throne, life’s anxieties or cares are to be thrown on His throne. Let us also be encouraged that His throne is one of grace of which, though we approach humbly, it can be approached confidently. (Hebrews 4:16)

As we humble ourselves before God rather than relying on our own selves, it is the “mighty hand of God” we can trust to lead us through whatever we are encountering in this life.
