Great Trust!

Psalm 112 begins. . . "Praise the LORD! Blessed is the man who fears the LORD, who greatly delights in his commandments!" (Psalm 112:1 ESV) From there is described a blessed life in a right relationship with God. Dropping down to verses 7 and 8 we read. . . "He is not afraid of bad news; his heart is firm, trusting in the LORD. His heart is steady; he will not be afraid, until he looks in triumph on his adversaries." (Psalm 112:7-8 ESV)


