New rules from the state will bring back the face mask requirement.

This is an excerpt from the Secretary of Health State of Washington from September 13, 2021

"Every person in Washington State must wear a face covering that covers their nose and mouth when they are in a place where any person from outside their household is present or in a place that is generally accessible to any person from outside their household, subject to the exceptions and exemptions below."

The exception that applies directly to us is as follows.

" While.... actively engaged in leading religious services"

Our interpretation is that masks stay on until that individual is in front of the congregation.

We feel confident that we were not infected but feel it wise to be cautious for a few days to make sure there are no symptoms. * Update: Before this was sent out the doctor called with an update on Angela. We are so thankful for all of you that prayed for Angela. The doctor shared that yesterday they were very worried for Angela and had her evaluated by the ICU doctors because they weren't sure she could tolerate the mask and they were considering intubation. She is a long way from coming home but is improving, they will try to wean her off of the

- machine and back to the high concentrate O2 through the nose.
- Sneads: Please pray for the Snead family, their daughter Kirschon, husband Gus and daughter Aubri have all tested positive for Covid. May God protect them all and bring them back to full health.
