Jeremiah tells God he is too young (Jeremiah 1:6). Jonah runs away (Jonah 1:3). These are typical human responses. We do not like change. We avoid having our lives altered, even if God is the one asking.

What do we miss when we tell God no? Abraham would have never left his home. Moses would have never become a leader. David would have never been king. Paul would have never planted all those churches. When we look back at the lives of the people we read about in Scripture, we can say one thing for sure. God knew best! None of those individuals understood their potential, but God did. God pursued them because He knew what they could become.

What are we saying no to? Is it helping to serve the poor, teaching a Bible class, inviting someone to lunch, or something else? Do we believe we're not qualified? That is what Moses thought. Are we afraid of getting out of our regular routine?

God is at work in this world. He presents us with many opportunities to serve him, but we have to say yes. We have to ignore our fears and trust God. We will never experience our full potential if we keep telling God no. God wants us to grow into faithful followers like Moses, David, Paul, and others, but we must be willing to follow his lead. God is inviting. It's up to us to say yes.
