The Right "If"!

When facing life's varied circumstances and situations, sometimes people begin with something like, "God, if you will . . . then I will. . .", as though beginning to bargain with God. However, for us to truly know God and trust the working of His Sovereign Will, rather than beginning to bargain we should instead be willing to surrender fully to Him in faith regardless of what might be taking place directly in our life or in the world around us.

This is exactly the kind of surrendered faith exhibited in the lives of <u>Hananiah</u>, <u>Mishael</u>, <u>and Azariah</u> who are most often remembered by their Babylonian names of <u>Shadrach</u>, <u>Meshach</u>, <u>and Abednego</u>. (Daniel 1:6-7) When they refused to fall down and worship the golden image set up by King <u>Nebuchadnezzar</u> -- even at the direct threat of their lives (Daniel 3:13-15) -- the unwavering faithfulness of these three to God prompted the response where we read...

"Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego answered and said to the king, "O Nebuchadnezzar, we have no need to answer you in this matter. If this be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of your hand, O king. 18But if not, be it known to you, O king, that we will not serve your gods or worship the golden image that you have set up."" (Daniel 3:16-18 ESV)

They knew what God was able to do! They acknowledged the power God had to intervene on their behalf. However, even if God did not deliver them, they would not bow! They fully surrendered to God regardless of whether they were spared or not!

As we pray regarding particular challenges, circumstances, or situations in our life, even if God does not change them, will we still trust Him? Will we still remain faithful to Him and His Will? Though we know the great power God has (i.e. Ephesians 3:20) to work on our behalf, will we patiently endure and hang in there in spite of not fully knowing what His present Will might be? Perhaps we are intended to grow stronger through the ordeal. It could be God is providing us the opportunity to be an example of faith (i.e. Hebrews 11:1) for others to witness as, in spite of the present, we trust Him for the eternal future He has promised.

If our trust remains in the right place, so will be the "if" in our circumstances. Even if we don't see what we think ought to be, trusting and patiently accepting the manner in which God chooses to work will always prove to be our best deal. May we trust Him to make it so!

Yvonne Lawrence's Memorial Service


will take place at the building, July 16, 2022 at 1:00pm.
