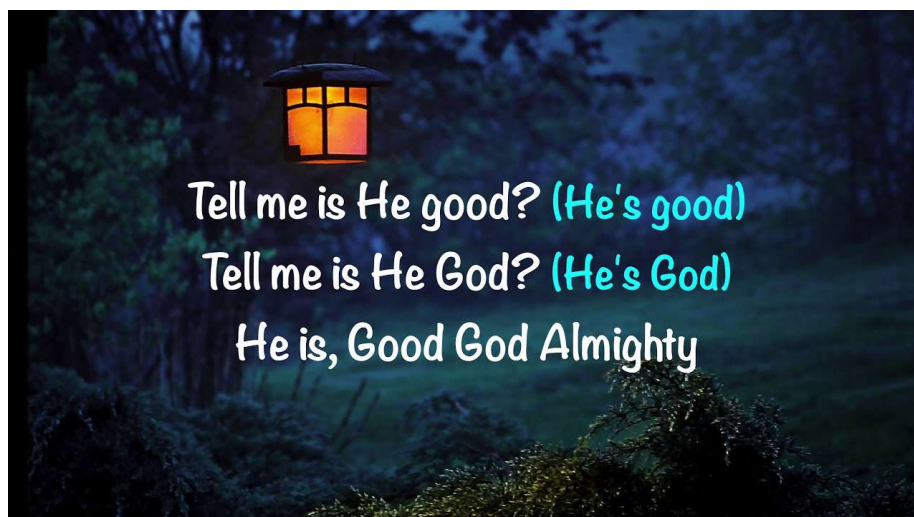
And James stated. . .
