What if.....

In those days Hezekiah became mortally ill. And Isaiah the prophet the son of Amoz came to him and said to him, "Set your house in order, for you shall die and not live." (2 Kings 20:1)

What if you could know of a certainty that you had only one more week to live on this earth? What would you do? Would you live that week any differently than you lived in previous weeks? What about your priorities, would there be any changes in that which is now most important to you? When Hezekiah was told to set his house in order because he was going to die, the Bible tells us that he turned his face to the wall and prayed to the Lord. In that prayer he reminds the Lord that he had walked before him in truth and with a perfect heart and had done that which was right in the Lord's sight (2 Kings 20:2-3). If you knew you had only one week to live, would you, could you, turn to the Lord with tears flowing from your eyes and pray the same prayer as Hezekiah? Interesting and a most sobering thought for all of us to consider, isn't it?

I sometimes wonder why we do not always live each day as if we knew it could possibly be our last day on this earth. None of us are guaranteed another moment much less another week on this earth. Not one single one of us knows what the next moment holds for us. This earthly life can come to an end in an instant of time, we just don't know when it will happen. Does that thought scare you or does it excite you?

I don't know about you but it excites me. I am proud to have had the privilege of living on this earth for some 88 years. There has been much joy and happiness in my life. There has also been a lot of pain and heartache. I love the refrain of the song that says, "Life here is grand with friends I love so dear, comfort I get from God's own word, Yet when I face the chilling hand of death, where could I go but to the Lord." My friends, the best is yet to come, heaven, a grand, beautiful and spectacular place lies just ahead and that excites me!
