#### A Mother's Influence

Sunday, May 14<sup>th</sup> is a day set aside in the United States in which mothers are honored. This is a day that traditionally involves gifts, flowers, cards, visits and phone calls to express a measure of appreciation. Sometimes there is a tendency to wax overly sentimental on Mother's Day and I suppose that it is well that it should be that way.

Someone once said, "there is no influence in the world today like the influence of a mother." While I believe this to be true, I would add the words, "especially a Christian mother". On December 23,1862, Abraham Lincoln wrote in a letter to a young girl who was deeply depressed over the death of her beloved father, "All that I am or even hope to be, I owe to my mother—God bless her."

While I am sure that there were other sources of good influence on his life other than just his mother, this is a great tribute paid to her. It is a tribute that speaks to the profound effect that our mothers have on shaping our lives. I believe with all my heart that in many homes the most influential member of that home is the mother. As I think about that, I am reminded of the words of Paul to Timothy, "For I am mindful of the sincere faith within you, which first dwelt in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and I am sure that it is in you as well." While Paul is the one from whom Timothy learned the message of the New Covenant, there is no doubting the tremendous impact the grandmother and mother had in shaping the life of Timothy (2 Tim. 1:13, 2 Tim. 3:14-15).

I hold in my heart many precious memories of my mother that will be with me for so long as I live on this earth. As I reflect on my life today, those words from Abraham Lincoln take on great meaning to me. I firmly believe that without the godly influence she had on my life it is likely that I would not be writing this message today or any other bible thought for that matter. I also pay a tribute to my beloved wife who for so long as she lived, provided for our four children a rock-solid foundation on which to build their lives.

For many of us our mothers are no longer with us on this side of eternity yet their influence on our lives still continues to have an impact on our life. To all who still enjoy the presence of their mother, I can only say to you, show them how much you appreciate them. Call them, visit them, talk to them, hug them and tell them that you love them. And don't confine this to just one day a year. Do it every day, every week, every month throughout the year. And if you really want to show how much you love and appreciate your mother, make sure that she is proud of you by the way you live your life each day. I can only imagine the joy that must have filled the hearts of Lois and Eunice as they thought about Timothy and the man he had become. You cannot overstate the value and influence of mothers!
