The Significance of Fellowship

If there was ever a pattern for the church to live by and imitate, it is Acts 2:42-47. This is the church unblemished. This is church as it should be. This does not mean the people who comprised the church were perfect. Church is messy because it is a community of imperfect people who are on a journey to be transformed into the image of Jesus. However, the model given in Acts 2 is untainted. It is what every church should be striving towards, no matter how ineffectively we execute it.

At the center of this model is fellowship. It is mentioned in verse 42 and then described in verse 46.

"Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts." (Acts 2:46)

This should come as no surprise to careful readers of the New Testament. Eating together was an integral part of Jesus' ministry. The only act of worship that Jesus himself instituted was a meal that is to be celebrated around a table. The end of Acts 2 is an extension of the life and ministry of Jesus. However, the idea of fellowship being central to the Christian faith is not always present in modern Christianity. Instead, we often view fellowship as an option or add on to the faith. It's nice but not necessary. This modern model would be quite perplexing to early Christians. They would not understand how anyone could be a follower of Jesus and never share a meal together with fellow Christians or use one's table for ministry and fellowship.

Eating together is not just a fun thing Christians do. It is the heartbeat of the church. It strengthens who we are. It allows us to form relationships so we can minister to one another. It builds bonds. It is a space where we open up, listen, and share. It is a time where we disciple and mentor people in the faith. It is an opportunity to encounter Christ as we practice being the hands and feet of Jesus to others and as they do the same for us. Jesus knew what he was doing when he called all of his followers to gather around a table each week.
