Jesus said, "You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled by men."

"You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. When I become lax in my daily worship-my Bible reading and prayer-my spiritual life suffers. But not just mine...my family is affected to generations yet unborn.

When I allow myself to become offended and turn away from the LORD and the church in bitterness, my eternity is affected. And so is that of my neighbors and friends, and my family to generations yet unborn.
