Trent and Michelle are following parallel tracks in Bible and Elizabeth is completing her degree in Deaf Ministry. They will graduate this spring from their two year intensive program! Congratulations! Tristen and Levi actively participate in Leadership Training for Christ at their home church and Tristen is interested in pursuing AIM (Adventures in Missions) when he graduates high school.

The only verse in the New Testament I can think of that uses the word easy when it talks about our Christian walk is Jesus' reassurance that his yoke is easy and his burden light (Matt. 11). This promise to those who follow Jesus certainly didn't guarantee safety or comfort (Paul dead in Rome, Peter crucified upside down). But it does guarantee guidance and proximity. It is still a yoke however, with the implicit understanding that you are not in control of your path while you wear it. The Herberts have

shown us a beautiful example of choosing to follow where they believe God has led them even if it means leaving the most beautiful place on earth and going to... Texas. You should hear their story about camping and lightning and basically running for their lives from tumbleweed in a storm!

Our support of their family allows them to be in school full time and keep their focus on education until they graduate. It also supports SIBI which has wide-ranging options for education. A few things they offer are online Master's and Bachelor's degrees in Bible that enable evangelists to continue in their jobs while furthering their education. They offer AIM* which empowers people of all ages, including gap year students between high school and college, with evangelism tools and then sends them to the mission field. They even have a solar powered device**, as small as a dime-store paperback, which contains the entire curriculum for the school and several hours of hymns that they can provide to missionaries to help teach people all over the world.

***If you have not already signed up, LifeLine Screening has offered discounts to 4 individuals. The discount is good for 1 Individual Screening (worth \$70) or you can have a \$55 discount off any vascular screening package valued at \$129 or more. The screenings are as follows: carotid artery screening, abdominal aortic aneurysm, PAD (peripheral arterial disease) screening, osteoporosis risk assessment, atrial fibrillation screening. One package includes all of these screenings and the other package includes all of them except for the osteoporosis risk assessment.
