Ladies Day Weekend Adventure

The Colbert church of Christ near Spokane, WA is hosting a Ladies Day on Saturday, April 28th 9:00am-3:30pm. Kelli Keagle and Sarah Benjamin are planning to go with our pre-teen daughters and are looking to see if anyone else wants to go as well. We plan to leave early Friday morning (4/27) and check in to a cabin at the Alderwood RV Park <https://highwaywestvacations.com/book/location/alderwood?room-Type=224&checkIn=&checkOut=> The cabins have shower, toilet, and kitchenette accommodations so that we can bring and prepare our own food and be ready for the Ladies Day and for services there on Sunday morning. After services, we

plan to go to the Cat Tales Zoological Park <http://www.cattales.org/hours-and-admission.html> before driving home. The cabins are about \$119 per day (we will have 2 days) and sleep 4 people, with 2 needing to be able to climb stairs to access the two loft beds. The downstairs bed is a double so two would have to be comfortable sharing a bed. This cost is not so bad when split 4 ways. There are also motel/hotel rooms in Spokane that you can reserve.
