Reflections...

March 1, 2020

Speaker – Bob McDaniel.

Bob McDaniel gave a 2-part sermon with great songs mixed in. What a worship service!

Part 1: 1 Peter 2:21. 25 years ago the church went through a book called, "In His Steps" written by Charles M. Sheldon in 1918. It was a group of Christians pledged to ask a question, "What would Jesus do?" for one year.

"WWJD" was popular with Christians until it died out. Bob wondered aloud if the reason it died off was the price of following Jesus that closely. How much of your life are you willing to give up? 100%, 50%, an hour and a half on Sunday?

Part 2: Matthew 16:24-28. Going back to the passage Avery used the week before. Are you willing to deny yourself, pick up your cross and come after Jesus?

Matthew 25:31-40 the theme for a youth ocean retreat 25 years ago. By denying yourself to serve others, you're serving Jesus.

Take away: Quit living life like the purpose of life is to survive safely at death. Jesus saved us, not to be safe, but to be spiritually *dangerous*!
