

# A Message from the Tiny Cabin Team

Homelessness concern in Kitsap County. It is affecting two-parent families, singleparent families, couples, singles, and teens. Homes for All is a Kitsap County group working toward providing safe, transitional housing for those who need it. Homes for All consists of 31 different entities across a variety of sectors including League of Women Voters, Central and South Kitsap School Districts, Olympic College, Kitsap Community Resources, Kitsap Connect, Kitsap Continuum of Care Coalition, Kitsap Rescue Mission, Kitsap Strong, The Salvation Army, YWCA of Kitsap County, Commissioner Garrido, South Kitsap Project Share, Kitsap Credit Union, Kitsap Mental Health Services, Kitsap Public Health, Peninsula Community Health Services, Kaiser Permanente Washington, Bremerton Housing Authority, Housing Kitsap, HUD, Victoria Hilt from Kitsap County, Community Development, Human Services, Prosecuting Attorney's Office, and Veterans Advisory Board - Kitsap County Sherriff, Washington Department of Corrections, United Way of Kitsap County, Suguamish Tribe, and Olympic Consortium. One project they are working on to provide transitional housing is a Tiny Cabin Village. This is a group of tiny cabins

is a growing (along with a bathroom cabin and kitchen cabin), set up concern in village-style, surrounded by security fencing and managed by various county services.

> In the fall of last year POCOC was approached by Homes for All and asked to consider placing a Tiny Cabin Village on our property. Shortly thereafter a piece of privately owned land, within city limits, was offered for this purpose and the discussion with POCOC and amongst us stopped. The city determined that the property offered was not suitable and once again conversation began at POCOC and with Homes for All. A fact-finding group, open to all, met this past Sunday. For the next 10 weeks we will work diligently to gather and share as much information as possible about tiny cabin villages.

> The fact-finding team will NOT be making a decision about placing a tiny cabin village on POCOC property. We will meet most Sundays after worship, post information regularly in the bulletin, Tuesday update, and on the prayer chain. We will develop a bulletin board and post the information we discover there.


have a ministry staff that would love to connect with you. Ask the people sitting around you for names of the ministry staff and to point them out!
