I have been thinking about that and our unending search for our purpose. I think we desperately seek it out because we have a deficit of God's purpose for us in our life. If we are not finding the time to seek God's will a hole opens up in us. We start to feel discontent.

I would suggest this week as you are going through your day that you stop and spend time ruminating on God's purpose for you. He has placed you right where you are with the hope that you will be His arms and feet. That you will be an instrument of Jesus' grace!
