Tiny Cabin Village Update

On Sunday, during the congregational meeting, the Tiny Cabin Village Team presented the information it's been gathering over the last 2-3 months about Tiny Villages. We distributed 3 packets of information and additional copies are and will be available in the foyer. We ask that over the next 5 weeks you prayerfully read through the provided materials and be praying for our discernment and God's will as we consider placing a Tiny Cabin Village on POCOC property. On July 8th as part of the next congregational meeting we will call for a vote to either move forward in the process or to not move forward. A yes vote will not guarantee a Tiny Cabin Village will be placed on POCOC land. There are several issues that remain to be worked through with the County for instance Community meeting/ input, legal contracts, tax and imminent domain concerns, and representation in the resident selection process. One or more of these items may hinder us in hosting a village. A yes vote would also give the team authority to represent POCOC in relationship with the County toward the goal of placing a tiny cabin village on POCOC land.

- ◆ We believe a tiny cabin village on POCOC land can be done safely, for our neighbors and for us.
- ◆ We believe a tiny cabin village on POCOC land can be done with little to no financial burden to POCOC.

- ◆ A Tiny Cabin Village could be the next step in an already established housing ministry for POCOC: a ministry that began more than 20 years ago with the purchase of the two duplexes for use as senior housing. Then about 8 years ago we began hosting transitional housing groups in the Heritage House, which continues successfully today. Most recently we've hosted and continue to host a homeless couple as they live in their travel trailer in our parking area.

Your team members are Bonnie Mitchell, Gary Chasteen, Ken Avery, Lisa Bratcher, Tim Duffy, and Wayne Hammock. On June 17th and July 1st we will be available, as a group, after worship to discuss the information presented as well as questions/ concerns you may have. During the next 5 weeks we will continue to gather and share information about the Tiny Cabin Village process and homelessness in Kitsap County. You will also hear about our personal journeys as team members.

Please keep the process and us in your prayers. Thank you.
