trial. After calling everyone I could think of, getting a ride from a stranger to the nearest gas station, and sitting dejectedly at a McDonalds just across the way I got a text back from Trent Herbert.

He came from a hard days work with his family in tow and helped me load my bike and safely transport it home! He really saved my bacon.

So this week the idea of generosity and family has been on my mind. Many people in their day to day don't get a solid picture of what it is that a church provides. The idea of "family" at church is a nice word, but not a practical idea. I think it is vitally important that we recognize sometimes what this family means and how it serves Christ.
