# Kitsap, WA

Coffee Oasis is a faith-based non-profit organization with a focus on providing stability to homeless youth (ages 13-25) in Kitsap County. The organization began in 1997 in Bremerton after seeing youth on the streets with nowhere to go. Since that time, it has grown to six locations, including one here in Port Orchard which began in 2010. Our congregation first became involved when the Friday night youth program began in Port Orchard. We continue to support Friday nights by providing meals every second Friday of the month.

The ultimate goal of the Coffee Oasis is to provide a way for teens to meet Jesus. In an interview with Paul, the youth director of the Port Orchard branch, he explained some of the ways they do this. He said, "we provide stability by being there when they need us, we give them consistency." "We help them seek jobs, work on better housing situations, and help them reconcile with family if possible."

At the Coffee Oasis site in Port Orchard they offer a day program from 2pm-5pm, Monday-Friday. The main focus of this time is to provide classes and discussions. They also provide counseling, which includes chemical dependency counseling. There are 30-35 youth actively involved in the afternoon program in Port Orchard and currently have two Case Managers. On Friday nights, a "hang-out" time is provided (this is when meals are brought in) and the numbers of participants in-

creases in upwards of 50 youth.

If you are interested in helping this organization there are a number of ways you can do that. Pray; purchase your coffee at Coffee Oasis sites (all proceeds goes back to supporting the youth program); provide a meal; volunteer your time with youth directly. To volunteer you do have to attend an orientation which they hold on the first Sunday of every month. On a personal note: I experienced a blessing by one of the youth who had been a part of the program and became a mentor. The setting was a Friday night and I was hanging out to get to know some of the kids. A young man entered and introduced himself to me. He was full of energy and smiles as he picked up a conversation with me. He shared with me where he had been. Without going into details, it had been a rough past. He had overcome a lot and had recently gained employment. Quoting scriptures to me, he was excited about life and his relationship with God. When he finished his story, he asked if I needed him to pray about anything in my life. I shared about a circumstance and he immediately prayed over me in a beautiful way that I will carry with me always. I have seen the fruit of this ministry and am thankful it is in our community.
