

# Tiny Village Update

There are four major components required for setting up a Tiny Village in South Kitsap. The landowner (leases the land on which the village will sit) **POCOC**: the funder (provides monies for village set up and operation) **Kitsap County**; the resident manager (provides for daily management of the village and resident case management) **Kitsap Rescue Mission**; the village owner (listed on the permit as owner of all structures and physical items and is responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of same). We recently received news that Kitsap Community Resources has made the decision to withdraw from the role of owner and the County is actively seeking a new nonprofit to fill this role.

So what does that mean for us? Well, mostly it means more waiting and more praying. It could be a step down the road of God showing us he doesn't want us to host a tiny village, we don't know. We do know this though; from the beginning God has used waiting to prepare his people for what he has planned for them. Maybe the waiting has nothing to do with anyone or anything other than us. Maybe like our predecessors of faith we are waiting as we are prepared for what God has planned. As we wait, please continue to lift up in prayer your Tiny Village Team (Bonnie Mitchell, Gary Chasteen, Ken Avery, Lisa Bratcher, and Wayne Hammock), our village partners, our neighbors, and that we allow God and not us to prevail in this endeavor, whatever the outcome.
