Time and again we will watch as people come and go looking for that perfect fit. Lots of times churches will cater, and even pander, to fitting their perceived audience. For a time there was a very real movement in the church to do just that, to find our audience and purpose and to follow it tenaciously.

We have for many years put people in leadership positions based on qualities our culture has taught us to be valuable. From hardworking salt of the earth blue collar guys, to white collar CEOs and business leaders. We have looked an looked for ways to maximize the efficiency of our church going experience.

This leads to its own host of issues and problems. Some of them we are even facing now! Dissatisfaction with the fit, boredom with the schedule. Feeling stale or lifeless because nothing is "new" enough to fit our fancy. As a people bombarded with messages about "needing" the new thing to be happy we find traditional church to be unappealing.

This doesn't just happen in one denomination or group, it happens across the board in big and small churches. It is a problem that has plagued the church for years and we cannot seem to break the cycle.

As consumers our experience isn't cutting it anymore. Forming a type of worship service that fits the group you have inevitably leaves some people out. It becomes a rigid practice in monotony. So instead we need to look with new eyes at an old problem.

Entrepreneurial eyes would see the experience we have as something to give someone else. If we look at the commission given to us by Christ we see a picture that looks different that faith by osmosis! We see a message and product that needs to be given effectively to all of humankind. So we need to look at it from the purest point of view we can.

What we are doing is all based culturally on the wrong point of view. Frequently we swing back and forth between modes of operation. If consuming isn't working we need to be salespeople! I don't think our answer is going to lie with the other side of the pendulum.

We meet and worship God on Sunday not for ourselves. Not for anyone else, not for any reason except the praise of our Lord. If we come not looking for some fix, not looking for some new improved way of doing things, but we come instead with a view based on praising our God, then what might church really be like?

If you find yourself feeling listless when at church, spend some time in prayer about how you view what happens there.
