

Drought!

The latest message we received from Roy Merritt:

In my 75 years living here in Zambia, I only remember one drought this serious, about 35-40 years ago.

The basic food for Zambians is corn meal mush. The crops failed this year, and so thousands of rural subsistence farmers in Zambia are hungry.

Corn meal is still available in town stores, but the price for a 50 kilogram bag, enough to feed a family for a month, has gone up to 150 kwacha. That's about US\$12 -- which sounds cheap to Americans, but it is a lot of money for a subsistence farmer who didn't have enough harvest from his fields to feed his family.

Regular rain normally starts in mid-October. Perhaps some folk who plant immediately can be eating their own vegetables in late November, and fresh corncobs by Christmas.

A \$50 gift from you will buy four bags of corn meal, pay part of the cost of hauling a truckload out into the countryside, and feed a typical village family for four months.

I will try to post more reports as we make progress on this very important project.

Just look at this grass! In a normal year, this grass would be 7-8 feet tall, and wonderful for thatching houses and chicken coops. This year it is only one and a half to two feet high.
