

# An Update from the Tiny Village Team

.....

Tiny Village Team continues to attend the monthly meeting of the Homes for All Leadership Group. Their goal is to end homelessness and includes 31 different entities including elected leaders, non-profit leaders, and private sector leaders. We have also met twice with a smaller leadership group that is directly involved in the tiny village process. We have been working on the resident screening/selection process and we hope to share the final version with you soon.

The County has asked Kitsap Rescue Mission (KRM), a local nonprofit, to manage the village. KRM's mission is to "assist the homeless and needy on the Kitsap Peninsula, who desire change, to experience the love of Christ and restoration of body, mind, and spirit" and this is their statement of faith.

#### "We believe -
