The Tiny Village is OUR Jericho!

What If... we were ONE VOICE, ONE BODY, that served our ALMIGHTY GOD, knowing full well that HE is in control and will keep us from ALL harm, if we truly seek HIM? Dare I say, we are not BOLD enough to challenge GOD to use us as HE needs us. WHY? on the committee for starters, and 2) understanding why they were, since several of them disagreed and were not at all interested in the idea. Over the past year, GOD has been working in them, through them, and with them to bring them to where they are today: a cohesive group that is striving to listen to GOD and HIS intent of using our property for the homeless here in South Kitsap County. They have given up countless hours of their OWN time, away from family, spending it together to meet, discuss, to PRAY, and mediate on our behalf with the County to find out THE BEST way to make this happen.

I also know that they have done everything they can to keep us engaged and educated, as well as offering a listening ear to hear about OUR OWN concerns, yes, ALL of us, because that is the charge they have taken on themselves, to be my voice of concern... which leads me to this: they have NO AGENDA except GOD's AGENDA. If GOD is for us, then who can be against us? GOD is able to do more than any of us can possibly think

or imagine...SO WHY CAN'T WE allow GOD to show us, our neighbors, and our community WHO HE IS! Can you imagine, if we could all get behind our committee, praying for them, and praying for GOD to use them, and us, in whatever way HE deems fit for our community? Imagine if we committed ourselves to meeting on the next six Wednesday evenings, rain or shine, and walk around the property line, in complete silence, not as a show of force, but as GOD's people asking HIM to bless our property for HIS use, for HIM to show HIMSELF, GOD ALMIGHTY, to our neighbors and our community. (Did you know our property is about five acres?) And on the seventh day, we "march" around our property line seven times and at a designated time after the seventh time around with us lined up around the property, we blared our horns and our voices out to GOD!!...WHOA...did you just feel that tremor?! What could GOD possibly do on that evening? Could we be so **BOLD** as GOD's people and "compel" God to make a move with our property for His Glory? Not us, but HIM. Who is with me?!
