

# What does God think of Money? By Tiffany Rousseau

Did you know that money is the most discussed topic in the bible?

It's true. There are over 2,000 verses about money and possessions (things that cost money) in the bible. Jesus' famous response to the Pharisees when asked about taxes is not his only commentary on money. In fact, Jesus is specifically addressing taxes in the Mark 12 passage, not ALL money and possessions. Jesus talks about money in Matthew 23:23, Mark 12:41-44, Luke 8:1-3, Matthew 17:24, Matthew 22:17, Luke 18:18, Luke 14:28, Luke 7:40, and many others. Paul gives instructions on using, saving, and giving money. The OT has many passages about money and possessions. What do we gather from this?

### Money is important to God.

That said, for the last four weeks, I have been teaching the children about money. It is easier to teach a child something new than to correct a bad habit or understanding in adults, so changing the way money is used for God's glory is most effectively done by teaching our children righteous ways of handling it.

We have used 4 classes to explore four key points:

- 1. Money is a gift from God that we **EARN**,
- Money is a gift that God wants us to GIVE,

- 3. Money is a tool that God says we should **SAVE**,
- 4. Money is a tool that God allows us to **SPEND**.

We are using three piggy banks to teach basic budgeting skills (instead of one big piggy bank) and illustrate these four points. The first piggy bank will be for giving to whatever cause the kids feel led by the holy spirit to donate it to. The second piggy bank will be for saving up to buy a new playground for our church, something I am teaching is an INVESTMENT. And the third piggy bank will be to spend on something both responsible and fun.

These three uses of money are all good and all ways God wants us to handle money. We don't need to GIVE it all, we aren't asked to SAVE it all, and we definitely shouldn't just SPEND it all. God allows us to do all three of these things with thanksgiving and praise to Him who provides. I am sharing this to encourage you to consider the choices you make with money. The children here are thinking about this topic, forming their understanding of something slightly foreign to them (with the exception of birthday money and allowance), and they are watching us. As Christ followers, we are supposed to reflect Him, in our actions, in our words, and even with our money. How are you reflecting Christ with your giving? With your saving? With your spending?

Go back to the first point: money is a **GIFT** from God that we earn. How are you being a good steward of your gift?
