These remote areas really need medical care. They have small government clinics, but it is not unusual to learn that they have no medicine. The 4th person on our team is Nordy Siabusenga, who works at Namwianga Hospital.

The four-man Westreach team is travelling in only one pickup, loaded with Lozi hymnbooks and Bibles, food, tents, and medicine. When they come to a village, Joe starts collecting kids, Shadreck and Dennis invite people to Bible study and hymnsinging, and Nordy makes his way to the local clinic or an empty classroom with a load of medicine . . .



Most of the patients Nordy has seen complain of malaria.
Our rainy season is also our malaria season.

The tents our guys have are not very waterproof, and it is rainy season!!!!
So the locals let them camp in this not-yet-finished house. At least it has a waterproof roof!



When the team reached Lenvu -- nobody came to welcome them! Some people had warned the villagers that the Westreach team was a group of Satanists! We had similar problems when we were planting churches up in Northern Zambia. Existing congregations do not want competition! The chief saw them, came, and invited them to visit him at his palace.



He apologised for the lack of people, and promised that many would come next time, because he would personally invite them!
