It drizzled and dripped all day Monday, and our streams were still trickling this morning, Thursday, Shimon and I trekked over to the Big Dam to check progress.

YES!

Water was up more than three feet from our last visit.

I tried to get Shimon to wade out to the exact spot where he stood for our photo last week, but he didn't want to get that wet! Water probably would have been up to his bellybutton, and he can't swim!



We walked on and noticed water is up to the base of the abandoned pumphouse . . .



So we walked around to see exactly how far we are from a full dam!
Shimon is touching the top of the water mark -- 7 or 8 bricks up -- about three feet.
Of course, the dam gets wider and wider as water rises, so it will take a lot of rain to push the level up another three feet.



Rainy season normally lasts into late March or early April, so we are hoping for 2 or 3 or 4 wonderful rainy days that will have water splashing over the spillways.
Thank you for your prayers and your gifts.
Village crops look okay -- not bumper-crop quality, but OK.
Hopefully this wonderful rain means we will not need to provide much food relief -- if any -- after the end of March.
