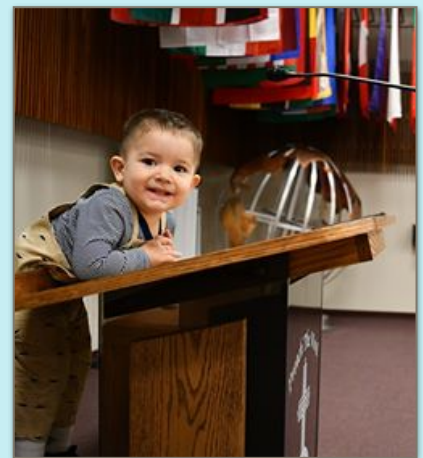


We connected with the former President of the Deaf and Blind Society of Washington. He was able to give us great insights into
